LIVE CD REQUIREMENTS AND ISSUES

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1. CONTENTS OF THE LIVE CD

1.1 Documentation

The documentation of the application can be found directly on the CD, under the folder *Documentation*. You can access it without booting from the CD.



1.2 Account Geneous Web

The CD is a bootable CD running the Account Geneous Web application within a SLAX Linux operating system. It does not access the computer's hard-disk and doesn't need an active network connection either.

The following components of Account Geneous Web are installed:

- Account Geneous Server
- Account Geneous WebClient
- Linux Agent
- Windows Agent

1. WORKING WITH THE LIVE CD

The AccountGeneous_10_2_Live.zip file contains the ISO image AccountGeneous_10_2_Live.iso.

First please extract the ISO from the archive, then burn it to a CD.

1.3 Burn the CD

The link below contains the instructions on how to burn an ISO image to a CD using Roxio Easy CD Creator® 5.x or Nero® Burning Rom 5.x.

1.4 Starting a demonstration

- boot up the computer from the live CD
- wait until the KDE desktop manager loads
- click on the "Server" icon from the desktop
- login to Account Geneous Web with the user **system**, password **system**

1.5 Exiting

In order to quit the live CD, reboot the system and remove the CD from you drive.

2. REQUIREMENTS

- x86 computer P4
- 1Gb of RAM
- Standard video, PS/2 mouse and keyboard
- Fast CD drive unit

2 OTHER ISSUES

2.1 Account Geneous documentation

On the live CD, the Account Geneous Web documentation (available in the application under the Help menu, Documentation submenu) can not be opened directly within the web browser. When clicking on one of the documents, the browser will prompt you with a dialog where you can choose to open the file or save it to disk. In order to view it, please select "save to disk". This will save a copy of the file on the desktop and you can open this copy with a double-click on it.

2.2 Saving Changes

The live CD does not store any of the information you enter during a session, does not access the computer's hard-disk and doesn't need an active network connection.
